WHAT CAN I EXPERIENCE?

- Victoria Falls remains one of the most spectacular natural wonders of the world
- South Luangwa, regarded as one of the greatest wildlife sanctuaries in the world and famous for its dense population of leopard
- Lake Kariba is Africa's largest man-made dam
- Kafue National Park is the oldest and largest (22 400 km²) of Zambia's national parks with an incredible diversity of wildlife
- The Lower Zambezi National Park lies along the Zambezi River and is relatively undeveloped and one of the few remaining pristine wilderness areas in Africa

BEST TIME TO GO?

May to August is Zambia's cool dry season. During this season temperatures drop at night, but the days are pleasantly mild. This is also the best time for game viewing because the foliage thins out making sightings easier and also animals concentrate at water sources.

September to November is also a good time for game, however this is the hot dry season so temperatures are higher.

Mid-November to mid-April is generally the wet season, or green season, and is ideal for bird-watching and the bush is thick, green and beautiful.

March to May is the best time to visit Victoria Falls as this is the end of the rainy season, when the falls are in peak flow.
